A total of 5 applications have been submitted to the Call for Support released on 01-01-2019. The Selection Committee (SC) made following decisions:

- 1. D. Pisanu Uni West Virginia (USA) → ASTRON (NL); 14.5-15.6.2019; requested 1500€:
  - SC allocated 1500€ for the support
- 2. P. McCauley TCD (IR) → ASTRON (NL), Q2 2019, requested 1400€
  - The SC approved a support of 400€ to one STM trip.
  - The date and the duration of the STM were not clearly specified. Any further STM trips require a new application. It has been suggested to be more detailed in any further application in providing information about the date/duration/affected person in the application form as well as in the invitation letter.
- 3. J. Steinbergs VUC (LV) → ASTRON (NL), April-May 2019, requested 900€
  - The SC approved a support of 600€ to one STM trip.
  - The date and the duration of the STM were not clearly specified. It has been suggested to be more detailed in any further application in providing information about the date/duration in the application form as well as in the invitation letter.
- 4. N. Gizani Hellenic Open University (GR) → AUT University (New Zeeland), 2 weeks in May 2019, requested 3000€
  - Not eligible.
    - An STM between non-RadioNet institutes cannot be supported.

The SC was very supportive of the proposed STM, and strongly suggested to take advantage of the experience of the RadioNet infrastructures owners into account.

- 5. D. Blinov Uni Crete (GR) → MPIfR (DE), 11-17.3.2019, requested 350€
  - Not eligible

Unfortunately RadioNet can only support staff exchange focussing on technical and operational aspects of the RadioNet infrastructures.

R. Keller steps down from his lead function. The entire panel has warmly thanked him for the entire effort over the years. The new leader will be Caroline Jaillot from ESO, after an official appointment of the Board
